Road Safety

As we approach the Easter break and Term 1 holidays, it's a timely reminder to everyone to be mindful of road safety near and around schools.

It's important all road users remember to slow down when driving near schools, especially at drop-off and pick-up times. Anyone driving on Fradd Road at the beginning or end of the school day will appreciate that it is very busy and potentially incredibly dangerous. Children and young people are at risk in road environments around schools for a number of reasons. They are smaller and less visible to drivers, their active behaviour can be less predictable than adults and they may have errors of judgement when dealing with traffic. We ask all drivers to be patient and respectful of children when driving near the school.

Students are also reminded of the importance of using the crossing, walking on the footpaths and being aware of their surroundings.

Healthy Recipe Ideas

Ingredients

egg
125gm margarine
cup raw sugar
cup natural Greek yoghurt
tbsp vanilla essence
cup reduced-fat milk
cup self-raising flour
cup wholemeal self-raising flour
cup desiccated coconut
400g tin pear slices in natural juice, drained



Method

Preheat the oven to 180°C. Grease and line a 20cm x 20cm square baking tin.

Place the first six ingredients into the bowl of a food processor, blender or stand mixer and mix until combined. Add the flours and coconut and mix until just combined. Dice half of the pear slices, add to the batter and mix through.

Spoon into the baking tin. Arrange the remaining pear slices on top to decorate. Bake for 25 minutes until golden and cake bounces back when touched. Allow to cool and then slice.

Store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to 7 days or freeze portions in a freezer safe container or freezer bags for up to 3 months.
